New Improvements!

The Lac du Bonnet Curling Club has installed a reverse osmosis water system from Pure Water. The purification system removes the impurities in the water making the ice harder. The ice and the pebble does not break down as fast providing more consistent speed for all eight ends making hits and draws easier for curlers. We have also purchased a new ice scraper and have all of our stones reconditioned this past summer. This makes our curling more fun with the rocks sliding farther, sliding out of the hack easier and the curl of the rocks more predictable. Together this makes for some cool ice and great fun for curlers of all ages.

Beginner and Intermediate Level Curling Clinics

Take this clinic if you can already on your foot (flat or toe slide), but would like to improve your technique for sliding and/or sweeping.
